

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- Borders Washington DC on Eastern Avenue
- US Route 1 (Rhode Island Avenue) is central corridor
- Four municipalities: Mount Rainier, Brentwood,
 North Brentwood and Hyattsville
- Community conversation started in 1996
- Roots in social equity, historic preservation, smart growth
- Designated by State of Maryland in 2001
- Consistent strategy over 15+ years
- Second decade of operation
- 12 anchor cultural facilities
- 20+ mid-size cultural nonprofits and arts enterprises
- 500+ artists living and/or working in district


































- Phase 3 = Creative industries incubator








CULTURAL CAPACITY


DISTRIBUTED LEADERSHIP

- Get grounded and stay present to a subjective yet clear and neutral view
- Accept the animating tensions but don't accept the fight
- Make your work a site of transformation
- Redirect negatives toward a shared good
- Don't react, re-focus and re-team
- Show, don't tell
- Love first, ask questions




INVENTIVE VISIBILITY


- Foreground artists' voices, practices, and perspectives
- Highest production values possible
- Pay creative producers as professionals
- Encourage collaboration between different media expertise
- Keep dollars circulating in creative community



ITERATIVE PRACTICE

- Acknowledge tensions between planning and iteration; logic and intuition; control and release
- Find the sweet spot together
- Balance process with outcome
- Document process to give it authority
- Train for process
- Use design thinking tools:
 - Gamestorming Cheat Sheet
 - IDEO Design Kit for Human Centered
 Design
 - Architecture of Everything
